
#### **SCIENTIFIC PREPARATION**

- The courses you shall take are determined by the Jury.
- •The maximum period of study in the scientific preparation program is at most two semesters. Students who fail at the end of two semesters are dismissed.



# **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

- You have to take 10 credit courses + Project course.
- You have to successfully complete 10 credit courses + Project course by the end of the third semester.
- Excluding the time spent on scientific preparation, the duration of education in a non-thesis Master's degree program is at least two and a maximum of three semesters
- You have to provide a GPA of 2.70, 30 credits and 60 ECTS credits.

### 1st SEMESTER: COURSE PERIOD

- Plan your courses for the semester with your academic advisor and register them.
- You have to register for at least two courses in the first semester.
- You are allowed to register for a maximum of <u>five courses</u> per semester.
- Determine your project advisor at the latest by the end of the semester.

### 2nd SEMESTER: COURSE/PROJECT PERIOD

- Plan your courses for the semester with your academic advisor and register them.
- You can register project course.

## 3rd SEMESTER: COURSE/PROJECT PERIOD

- Plan your courses for the semester with your academic advisor and register them.
- At the end of 3 semesters, you have to successfully complete 10 courses+ Project course in the curriculum.
- If your GPA is below 2.70 despite successfully taking all 10 courses at the end of 3 semesters, you are granted to use the right of additional exam for the courses for which you have received CB or CC grades.
